



21+3 WITH A TOP SIDE BET

THE TWO MOST POPULAR CARD GAMES, BLACKJACK AND THREE CARD POKER, MERGED INTO ONE!

21+3 is an optional proposition wager on the game of blackjack and is based on a 3 card hand using the dealer's one (1) up card and the player's two (2) initial up cards to form a 3 card poker hand. Winning hands of a Straight Flush, 3 of a Kind, Straight and flush are paid 9 to 1.

HOW TO PLAY

21+3 wagers must be in accordance to the posted betting limits. A player will only be paid for 1 winning event even though the three card hand may contain 2 winning events (ex: three 8 of diamonds). One payoff 9 to 1.

HAND RANKINGS

FLUSH - Three cards of the same suit.

STRAIGHT - Three cards in sequence. (Ace can be used to achieve an Ace, 2, 3 Straight or Ace, King Queen Straight)

THREE OF A KIND - Three cards of the same rank.

STRAIGHT FLUSH - Three cards in sequence and the same suit.

TOP 3 SIDEBET

START OF GAME

Prior to the start of each round of blackjack play; players may optionally make a TOP 3 wager in combination with their primary blackjack and +3 wager. The TOP 3 wager is placed on the designated area on the table layout at the same time their primary blackjack wager and +3 wager is made and before any cards are dealt.

DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

Once the dealer has dealt two cards to each player and two cards to themselves (1 up, 1 down), the dealer must determine if any players who have made the +3 and TOP 3 wagers have achieved a winning hand. A player can win their +3 wager and TOP 3 wager in the same hand. Conversely, a player could win their +3 wager and lose their TOP 3 wager.
